²⁵ NT5101 Greek I and NT5102 Greek 2 can count as a general education elective, an upper level Bible/theology elective or a free elective. In this example it is counted as an upper level Bible/theology elective which will leave 3 hours in that category. If a student chooses to count it in one of the other categories, that category must be increased by 3 hours per Greek class and the upper level Bible/theology class must be increased by 3 hours per Greek class.
